Eligibility

Current and retired members' of AFSCME 1201 children and grandchildren who are currently Seniors attending High School in Rutland and Addison Counties in VT. At least one year of continuous union membership by the affiliated member. The one-year membership minimum must be satisfied by May 31, 2021.

Application Timeline

Applications are currently available in high school guidance offices. Completed applications must be returned to the high school guidance offices on or before 12:00 p.m. (Eastern Time) on Friday, April 9, 2021. Applications received after this deadline will not be considered.

Scholarship Award Amounts

Scholarships in the amount of \$250 each. These one-time cash awards are for study beginning in the Fall of 2021.

Award Date

The Scholarship Committee will determine recipients of scholarship awards by the first Friday of May each year. During the first week of June award recipients will be individually notified by mail, and all applicants will be sent an email with notification that the award list is posted. Please note that due to the volume of applications we cannot provide any information on the status of an application before award announcements are made.
