She was an outgoing and vibrant professional woman who valued each and every person with whom she worked. She was respected for her intelligence, hard work, sincerity and dedication to giving the very best of herself in all that she did. As a devoted mother and firm believer that all students have the potential to be successful members of their community, Carol was known for her capacity to love and give deeply of herself and her talents as witnessed by the many nurses she mentored during her long career at Rutland Regional.
